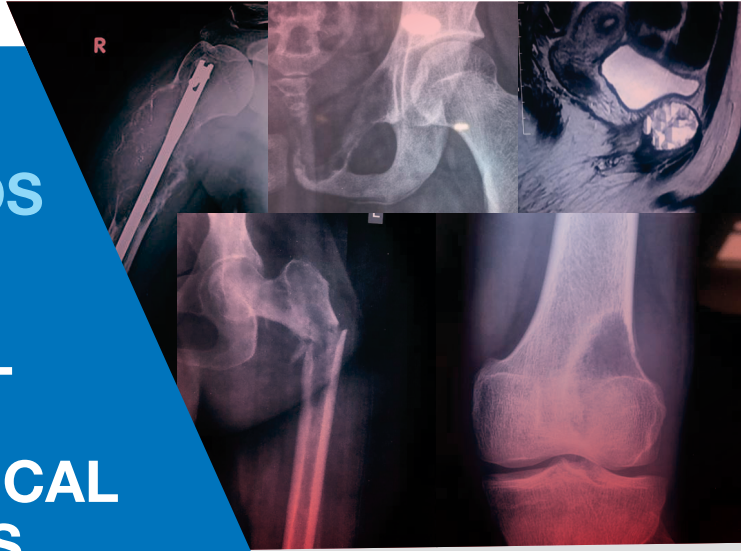

Giant cell tumors are locally aggressive bone tumors with controversial management strategies, especially in the recurrent setting. Moreover, newer insight into the biology of this disease has brought forth many advances in the treatment options available.

The content of the program is targeted towards residents and practicing orthopedic surgeons. The CME will have focused lectures on pertinent issues followed by panel discussion by eminent national and regional faculty.
